

LEVEL 3 CERTIFICATE IN CHRISTIAN COUNSELLING

WHO IS THE COURSE FOR:

This I year part-time course is suitable for those wishing to:

- learn more advanced counselling skills (listening and responding) in helping roles such as pastoral support, teaching environments, health and social care professions
- find out more about counselling theories
- progress onto a diploma course that will enable successful students to practise as a qualified counsellor
- improve professional and personal relationships as their capacity for empathy increases.

This qualification does not lead directly to an employed role. The course is open to all adults however it is important you are not experiencing severe emotional stress at the time of entering the course.

The course is run at the Manna House Counselling Service in Northampton town centre every Monday evening from 6.15pm -9.30pm with a 15 minute break.

Autumn Course:

Monday 23 September 2024 to 9 June 2025 30 sessions 6.15pm - 9.30pm + 2 Saturdays 9.30am - 5pm (1 hr lunch)

FEES

The course fee is **£950**, this includes notes and registration with CPCAB

Course fees may be paid in full or by monthly instalments over the duration of the course

A deposit of £150 is required with completed application forms

Please note all courses are run subject to sufficient student uptake.

ABOUT THE COURSE

The course material is based upon the CWR model of training but has been altered and updated to meet the specific needs experienced through our counselling in the community over the last thirty-seven years.

In addition to teaching sessions, group work and directed discussions, there will be 9 written assignments to complete.

We follow Northamptonshire School term dates and students must attend at least 85% of the course to pass. Completion of the course can be used to support applications for a higher educational programme of study.

Please note all courses are run subject to sufficient student uptake. Decisions to run a course are made up to two weeks before the start date. Should a course be cancelled by Manna House then your full deposit and any course fees paid will be refunded.

*Students must attend at least 85% of the course to pass.

1. Qualifications needed?

Ideally students will have successfully completed an accredited Level 2 counselling course or equivalent to qualify for acceptance. An interview will be required prior to acceptance and you are therefore advised to make your application as soon as possible. Interviews will be held in August.

2. IT Requirements (F2F/Online courses)

Ideally you should have good literacy and IT skills. For our combined F2F/Online courses Manna House use the Microsoft Teams platform (free to download). Students will need to install Microsoft Teams onto a suitable device, preferably a laptop or PC, in preparation for the course. Opportunity will be given for a pre-course check-in.

3. Further Training

Following successful completion of this course, students will be eligible to apply for further training at Level 4 either through Manna House or elsewhere (requirements vary so please check with individual training providers.

Manna House run a P/T one-year Level 4 Diploma in Christian Counselling - TM4D/I on Tuesday evenings during term time +1 Saturday per month. The next Level 4 Diploma course is scheduled to begin September 2025.
