

LEVEL 4 DIPLOMA IN CHRISTIAN COUNSELLING

WHO IS THE COURSE FOR:

This 2 year part-time course is suitable for those wishing to:

- qualify and seek professional registration as a counsellor
- learn more advanced counselling skills (listening and responding) in helping roles such as pastoral support, teaching environments, health and social care professions
- find out more about counselling theories
- complete a diploma course that will enable successful students to practise as a qualified counsellor (ACC or BACP)
- improve professional and personal relationships as their capacity for empathy increases.

This qualification does not lead directly to an employed role. The course is open to all adults however it is important you are not experiencing severe emotional stress at the time of entering the course.

This course is run at the Manna House Counselling Service in Northampton town centre, Opposite the rail Station.

FEES

The course fee is **£5,292**, this includes notes and registration with CPCAB. Course fees may be paid in full or by monthly instalments as follows:

A **deposit of £292** is required with completed application forms, then **£250p.m. for 20 months**

ABOUT THE COURSE

The 'Counselling and Psychotherapy Central Awarding Body' (CPCAB) have validated our newly revised and updated Manna House Counselling Service 'Diploma in Christian Counselling'.

This comprehensive course meets all the latest stringent requirements and expectations of the professional counselling community. Please note this new course is our own bespoke/Tailor-Made Christian course based around the Christian '5 Circle Theory' practiced here at the Manna House and not a generic CPCAB Level 4 Diploma.

In addition to teaching sessions, group work and directed discussions, there will be written assignments to complete.

We follow Northamptonshire School term dates and students must attend at least 85% of the course to pass. Completion of the course can be used to support applications for a higher educational programme of study.

Please note all courses are run subject to sufficient student uptake. Decisions to run a course are made up to four weeks before the start date. Should a course be cancelled by Manna House then your full deposit and any course fees paid will be refunded.

1. Qualifications needed?

Ideally students will have successfully completed an accredited Level 2 and Level 3 counselling course or equivalent to qualify for acceptance. An interview will be required prior to acceptance and you are therefore advised to make your application as soon as possible. Interviews will be held in August.

2. IT Requirements (F2F/Online courses)

Ideally you should have good literacy and IT skills. For our combined F2F/Online courses, Manna House use the Microsoft Teams platform (free to download). Students will need to install Microsoft Teams onto a suitable device, preferably a laptop or PC, in preparation for the course. Opportunity will be given for a pre-course check-in.

3. Counselling Placement

In year two, each student must complete 100 hours of supervised counselling to obtain their final Diploma. Students can apply to the Manna House to do their 100 hours or organise an alternative placement elsewhere. Students will need to pay for their own supervision.

On completing the placement, students can apply to work as a volunteer counsellor for the Manna House.

Please note, students have up to 12 months from the end of academic studies in which to complete their 100 hours placement.
