

LEVEL 3 CERTIFICATE IN CHRISTIAN COUNSELLING

WHO IS THE COURSE FOR:

This 1 year part-time course is suitable for those wishing to:

- learn more advanced counselling skills (listening and responding) in helping roles such as pastoral support, teaching environments, health and social care professions
- further explore counselling theories
- progress onto a diploma course that will enable successful students to practise as a qualified counsellor
- improve professional and personal relationships as capacity for empathy increases.

This qualification does not lead directly to an employed counselling role. However, it will further equip students to work effectively in various pastoral care contexts and is the gateway training for the Level 4 Qualifying Diploma. The course is open to all adults and is run at the Manna House Counselling Service based in the University of Northampton Innovation Centre in Northampton with easy access to parking and the train station.

FEES

The course fee is **£1,161**, this includes notes and registration with CPCAB.

Course fees may be paid in full or by monthly instalments over the duration of the course.

A deposit of £161 is required with completed application forms.

ABOUT THE COURSE

The Counselling Approach used at the Manna House is based on the Five Circle Theory originating with the Waverley House (CWR) Training Centre. It is an holistic Christian integrative model that emphasizes the interconnectedness of different aspects of a person's life.

In addition to teaching sessions, group work and directed discussions, there will be nine written assignments to complete.

We follow Northamptonshire School term dates and students must attend at least 85% of the course to pass. Completion of the course can be used to support applications for a higher educational programme of study.

Please note all courses are run subject to sufficient student uptake. Should a course be cancelled by Manna House then any course fees paid will be refunded.



1. Qualifications needed?

Ideally students will have successfully completed an accredited Level 2 counselling course or equivalent to qualify for acceptance. An online interview will be required prior to acceptance and you are therefore advised to make your application as soon as possible.

2. IT Requirements (F2F/Online courses)

Ideally you should have good literacy and IT skills. For our combined F2F/Online courses Manna House use the Microsoft Teams platform (free to download). Students will need to install Microsoft Teams onto a suitable device, preferably a laptop or PC, in preparation for the course. Opportunity will be given for a pre-course check-in.

3. Further Training

Following successful completion of this course, students will be eligible to apply for further training at Level 4 either through Manna House or elsewhere (requirements vary so please check with individual training providers).

Manna House run a P/T two-year Level 4 Diploma in Christian Counselling - TM4D/I on Tuesday evenings during term time + 1 Saturday per month. The next Level 4 Diploma course is scheduled to begin September 2026.
