# ABOUT THE COURSE

Our Level 2 Award in Introduction to Christian Counselling course TM2A/A offers a balance of theory and skills with subjects covering:

- Counselling theory and Biblical basis
- Counselling skills
- Relationships
- Difference and diversity
- Specific client applications
- Principles, ethics and procedures

The course consists of 36 hours of teaching time and 14 hours of private study time which involves further reading, keeping a personal learning journal and 3 written assignments.

It is the equivalent to 6 educational credits which can be used to support applications for a higher educational programme of study.

**\*Students must attend at least 85% of the course to pass.**

## 1. Qualifications needed?

No specific qualifications are required however you will be expected to complete 3 course assignments which consist of multiple questions requiring short 1/2 - 1 page of A4 per question. Ideally you should have good literacy and IT skills

## 2. IT Requirements (Online courses)

For our Online courses Manna House use the Microsoft Teams platform (free to download). Students will need to install Microsoft Teams onto a suitable device, preferably a laptop or PC, in preparation for the course. Opportunity will be given for a pre-course check-in.

## 3. Further Training

Following successful completion of this course, students will be eligible to apply for further training with Manna House at Level 3 and with some other Training Providers (requirements vary so please check with individual training providers).

Manna House run a one-year Level 3 Certificate in Christian Counselling - TM3C/H which is a blended course, consisting of one Friday evening and Saturday daytime per month and Monday evenings online. The next Level 3 course is scheduled to begin January 2027 making our Summer School and Autumn Training ideal for those wishing to progress to our Level 3 Certificate Course.
